Survey conducted May 17 through May 18, 2017. 629 likely 2017 Special Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2017 Special Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.9%. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.
